Minutes of the YRALIS PHRF Committee Via Zoom June 13, 2024

Present: Alistair Duke (Chair), Mike Colucci, June Kendrick, Rick Sinclair, Andrew Weiss

Guests: William Clemens (Bolt 37 Coyote), Brian McCloskey (GP 42 Arma), John Dumke (Custom 44 Emily)

Chair Alistair Duke called the meeting to order @ 2032.

William Clemens had been invited to attend to discuss his rating and the 9-12 second delta for the nonspinnaker rating. Current rating is 3/-3/12/12. It was decided to set the base rating for the Bolt 37 at 3, backing out the sprit adjustment and then to apply the sprit table for the sprit. That gives a new net rating of -3/-9/3/3.

Brian McCloskey was invited to attend for a discussion on his rating and how the error in his ORC certificate affected the initial rating set for the GP 42 Arma. Current rating is -21 base. New base is set to -27.

John Dumke was invited to attend to discuss any changes made to the boat. Emily is aluminum. The teak decks were replaced, which required replacing some of the aluminum deck plates due to corrosion. The interior has been refurbished. The centerboard is still pinned in the up position and the slot has been sealed. The committee determined that nothing had been done that warranted any change in rating. Current rating of 124/114/120/114 stays.

Jeanneau 349 – current rating 135/129/135/129. It appears that the distance offset was never removed years ago when these were removed for most boats. New rating 135 all. These came with 3 different keels – fixed @ 6.5' w/3,483 # ballast, wing @4.9 with 4,101 # ballast, and a lifting keel of 4.8 - 8.33' with 3,377 # ballast. All ballasts are cast iron. Inclination (rated 2015-2017) is a fixed keel. Conundrum is a wing keel @ 5.9' (rated 2018-2019) and Sea Geek (ex-Pelagic) is a 4.9' Wing. The rating is for the fixed keel. Make a Wing keel version @ 141 all & move Sea Geek to it.

Beneteau Oceanis 54 - 42 all, use sprit table. This is the 2023 model, not the 2009 Beneteau 54. DR 6.5.

Alden 42 Caravelle Yawl – 147 all.

Jeanneau 64 – 15 all. Use sprit table.

Lapin – Farr 47. This was an Oakcliff boat. It has a keel mod.

IC 37 – We declined to discuss this further after setting the rating last month. More data on racing in LIS is desired.

The ECSA position paper on ORC was discussed.

The meeting was adjourned at 2230.
